Welcome to the wonderful CHRISTmas season! As I've been reflecting on my 'word-for-the-year', I have realized that, although it's just one simple word (*nothing*), it has served to teach and encourage me in so many ways and has been my repeated reminder that **nothing** can separate me from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord (check-out Romans 8:38-39).

Now as I think about Christmas, I am reminded that its meaning is also summed up in one word, Emmanuel. It's used in Isaiah (7:14) to as a sign to King Ahaz, predicting the future virgin birth of the Messiah. Those words are quoted by Matthew (1:23) in his gospel account of Christ's birth. Immanuel (or Emmanuel) means "God with us". What can be more simple than that? It does not solely mean God was with us once, or God will be with us in the future, but He is simply with us always. His elaborate and loving plan to send His Son to take our place is explained in that one word, Emmauel. With all we add to it....Christmas really that simple. Don't miss that in your rituals and the frenzy that the season can bring. Thanks for all that were able to attend our fall kickoff. Ricki Kraines did a wonderful job of looking back to remember the gospel (we are more loved and accepted in Jesus than we ever dared hope), the Word of God (that transforms, empowers, and delights), and the testimony of His work in our lives (He has been faithful in the past and will be faithful once more).
